These Zoom lessons are great for allowing the teacher to focus on certain aspects of work assigned to the children, it also gives children some well needed structure and it is a time to interact with their teachers and friends. We really appreciate the support from parents as you have enabled us to implement the Zoom lessons without any difficulties.

• **Cruinnithe Tuismitheoirí Múinteoirí**
